



## Cert in Supporting Teaching and Learning - Level 2 - N120

This is a vocational qualification for to prepare you for a career as a teaching assistant.

### COURSE DETAILS

The Supporting Teaching and Learning qualification includes mandatory units, work placement in a school to assess skills practice..

- Child and Young Peoples Development.
- Safeguarding.
- Communication/Professional Relationships.
- Supporting aspects of behaviour.
- Display Work.

Placement is weekly minimum 12 hours per week.

### ENTRY GUIDELINES

To study a Level 2 qualification, you will need:

A minimum of 3 GCSEs at grade 3, including English Language (or L1 Functional Skills in English) or Maths GCSE grade 3 (or L1 Functional Skills in maths)

Or a relevant Level 1 qualification and GCSE grade 3 in English language or Maths.>

### EQUIPMENT REQUIRED

A suitable device such as a laptop to create your e-portfolio of work. There is also a course textbook which would be helpful, this is also available from the college library. You will complete a DBS with us before you start your work placement in a school. You will need to purchase a placement uniform, there is bursary support available to help with the cost of the uniform.

## ASSESSMENT METHOD

Assessment is via coursework and direct observation of skills practice in the workplace.
