This course is designed to equip you with the core skills and knowledge needed to begin a rewarding career in woodwork and site carpentry. As well as learning hands-on techniques in measuring, cutting, and assembling materials, you'll build your confidence, teamwork, and communication skills to help you thrive in the workplace. You'll focus on carpentry-specific training while preparing for progression onto a Level 2 qualification in Carpentry and Joinery.

COURSE DETAILS

You'll develop your carpentry skills alongside improving your Maths, English, and digital abilities — all essential for your future career. Guided by experienced tutors, you'll receive tailored support, constructive feedback, and industry insights. Through tutorials, guest speakers, and hands-on work experience, you'll build your confidence, strengthen your communication, and prepare for interviews and employment in the Carpentry and Joinery trade.

You will study:

- Health, safety and welfare in construction and associated industries
- Knowledge of construction technology
- Knowledge of technical information, quantities and communication with others
- Maintain and use carpentry and joinery hand tools
- Prepare and use carpentry and joinery portable power tools
- Produce woodworking joint

3 days per week incorporating maths, English, work experience and tutorial.
